

VISITATION GUIDELINES in lieu of COVID-19

Effective immediately, in accordance with guidance from California Dept. of Public Health (CDPH), the following Visitor restrictions will be in place to ensure the safety of our patients and healthcare personnel.

Visitation will be based on the community disease transmission risk for COVID 19 within the county as published by LA county public health.

1. For private rooms, allow one family member per day.
2. For semi-private rooms, allow one family member per day.
3. Visitors are not allowed for patients who are being r/o for COVID 19 until results available.

For the specific population listed below, expanded visitation guidelines is allowed, regardless of COVID 19 county positivity rate.

1. *Pediatric patients – 2 visitors per day*
2. *Patients in labor and delivery – 2 visitors per day*
3. *NICU & PICU patients - 2 visitors per day*
4. *Patients at end-of-life – 2 visitors per day*
5. *Patients with physical, intellectual, and/or developmental disabilities and patients with cognitive impairments – 2 visitors per day*
6. *Students obtaining clinical experience - allowed*
7. *Surgery patients – 2 visitors per day*

❖ **All persons entering the facility must present:**

- **Identification** (DL, Senior ID, passport) and **one** of the following:
- **A valid Covid-19 vaccination card** showing a completed 2 dose vaccination regimen (Pfizer or Moderna) or a completed 1 dose vaccination regimen (J&J).

OR

- **A valid negative Covid-19 test result** collected within the last **72hrs** (PCR or Antigen test)
- Exceptions may only be made based on the State Public Health order.

- ❖ All visitors must be screened for fever and Covid-19 symptoms and be asymptomatic for Covid-19 and not be suspected or recently confirmed case (within prev. 2 weeks)
- ❖ All visitors must wear a face cover upon entry and other PPE as appropriate while in the patient's room.
- ❖ Visitors should not walk around in hallways and must go directly to and from the patient's room.
- ❖ Community visitors will not be permitted to the hospital's cafeteria for the sole purpose of dining.
- ❖ Duration of visitation has to be determined on a case by case basis.

We recognize that this is an extraordinary situation locally, nationally and globally and thank you for your support of these measures as a way to keep our patients, visitors, employees and community safe.
