

VISITATION GUIDELINES in lieu of COVID-19

In accordance with California Dept. of Public Health (CDPH), the following visitor guidelines will be in place to ensure the safety of our patients and healthcare personnel:

1. For all patients, allow one immediate family member per day; visitation will be allowed for 2hrs.
2. There will be **no, IN and OUT** privileges.
3. Visitors not allowed for patients who are confirmed covid-19 and being r/o for COVID 19 until results available.
4. Exception may be allowed for patients who are at end of life.

❖ **All persons entering the facility must present:**

- **Identification** (DL, Senior ID, passport) and:
- **Covid-19 vaccination proof** showing complete 2-dose vaccination regimen (Pfizer or Moderna) or a completed one-dose vaccination regimen Johnson & Johnson.

OR

- **A valid negative Covid-19 test result** collected within **72 hours** (PCR or Antigen test)

- ❖ All visitors must be screened for fever and Covid-19 symptoms and be asymptomatic for Covid-19 and not be suspected or recently confirmed case (within prev. 2 weeks)
- ❖ All visitors must wear a facemask upon entry and other PPE as appropriate while in the patient's room.
- ❖ Visitors should not walk around in hallways and must go directly to and from the patient's room.
- ❖ Visitors are not be permitted to the hospital's cafeteria.

We recognize that this is an extraordinary situation locally, nationally and globally and thank you for your support of these measures as a way to keep our patients, visitors, employees and community safe.
