



VISITOR RESTRICTION GUIDELINES in lieu of COVID-19

Effective immediately, the following Visitor restrictions will be in place to ensure the safety of our patients and healthcare personnel.

- No visitors to inpatient areas including medical surgical units, telemetry units, and critical care units.
- No children under the age of 14
- No children under age 18 in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (healthy parents may visit at any time)
- Only one healthy visitor for patients in labor and delivery and postpartum units.
- Only one healthy visitor for all patients having procedures including surgery, outpatient surgery, GI laboratory, radiology, cardiac catheterization laboratory and any other procedural areas.
- Only one healthy visitor for all emergency department patients.
- Exceptions to the policy may be made for those patients receiving end-of-life care or who have extraordinary circumstances and be made in consultation with nursing supervisor.
- No community visitors will be permitted to the hospital's cafeteria for the sole purpose of dining.
- Any visitor who exhibits body temperature greater than 100 F or signs and symptoms of illness may not visit hospitalized patients.

We recognize that this is an extraordinary situation **locally**, nationally and globally and thank you for your support of these measures as a way to keep our patients, visitors, employees and community safe.
